If you're driving a vehicle, you only need to tell police your **NAME** and **ADDRESS***.

*Unless the police suspect you have witnessed or committed a specified crime. In this case, you are also required to give your date and place of birth, and your nationality.

Answer "**NO COMMENT**" to all other questions.

Passengers **don't** need to give any details.

If asked, you have **7 DAYS** to produce a valid driving licence, vehicle insurance certificate, and MOT certificate.

The police **don't** have a general power to search your vehicle. Ask: "**UNDER WHAT POWER?**"
